Choose one of the following – Due **Oct 25, 2013**

1. **2- minute skit** (2 or more people) about the American Revolution, Enlightenment Ideas, Magna Carta, Declaration of Independence, Constitution
2. **An Historical Object** – Describe it to the class, and what function did it serve, must be from the time period we are studying
3. **A Diorama** (3-D display)– Any of the American Revolution battles, Continental Congress, The Estates General, The National Assembly (Tennis Courts), The Bastille, Versailles Palace
4. **A Timeline** of the ancient world Include 20 -30 events, the English War of Roses to the Glorious Revolution, The American Revolution, The French Revolution, The Napoleonic Wars
5. **A Map of** – The Roman Empire, The Holy Roman Empire, The New World Possessions of the Spanish Empire, The American Revolution, the Napoleonic Wars

You will need to use resources outside of your book. Gather as much information as possible. Completed projects (Diorama, Timeline, Map) should be large enough for the class to see from the front. Only the Skit and Historical Object require presenting to the class.

Show Me What You Know 2nd Q

Choose one of the following – Due **Jan 17, 2014**

1. **2- minute skit** (2 or more people) about Seneca Falls, Life in the factories, Child Labor, Karl Marx vs Adam Smith
2. **An Historical Object** – Describe it to the class, and what function did it serve, must be from the time period we are studying
3. **A Diorama** (3-D display)– A Factory, Canal, Factory Town, Steam Engine, Lowell Mills, First Power Station, working coal or iron mine, Robert Owen's Utopia, Assembly Line, Florence Nightingale at Crimea, Nightlife in the Cities, Emerging Middle Class Home, etc...
4. **A Timeline** Include 20 -30 events, The Industrial Revolution, History of Invention, Unions and labor rights, Women's Movement,
5. **A Map of** – The Voyage of the HMS Beagle (Darwin's voyage), Nationalism in Europe, Unification of Germany, Unification of Italy, Russo-Japanese War, European Uprisings from 1800-1910
6. **A Display of** – A display of Art styles with descriptions, Architecture Styles

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Show Me What You Know 3rd Q

Choose one of the following – Due **Mar 21, 2014**

1. **2- minute skit** (2 or more people) Imagine the discussion between The Kaiser and the Tsar, Lenin's Speech at St Petersburg, The Treaty of Versailles
2. **An Historical Object** – Describe it to the class, and what function did it serve, must be from the time period we are studying
3. **A Diorama** (3-D display)– WWI Trench warfare, Tanks, Poison Gas, Planes, Defense in depth, etc...
4. **A Timeline** Include 20 -30 events, WWI, Russian Revolution, Japan's Rise to Power, Nationalism around the world
5. **A Map of** – WWI Conflicts (Worldwide, or in Europe or Africa, Or specific Battles), Europe before and after WWI, Latin American Nationalism movements, Russian Revolution
6. **A Display of** – A display of Art styles with descriptions (African Arts, Latin American Arts, Asian Arts...), Gandhi's Non-violent peace movement

You will need to use resources outside of your book. Gather as much information as possible. Completed projects (Diorama, Timeline, Map) should be large enough for the class to see from the front. Only the Skit and Historical Object require presenting to the class.

Show Me What You Know 4th Q

Choose one of the following – Due **Jun 06, 2014**

1. **2- minute skit** (2 or more people) Do a portion of Martin Luther King Jr's Speech at the Lincoln Memorial, Kennedy's call for civil service and going to the moon. Edward R. Murrow's challenge to McCarthy.
2. **An Historical Object** – Describe it to the class, and what function did it serve, must be from the time period we are studying
3. **A Diorama** (3-D display)– Apollo 11 landing on the Moon, The Berlin Wall, a Bomb Shelter, The suburbs created for returning GI's,
4. **A Timeline** Include 20 -30 events, WWII, The Cold War, Civil Rights, The Space Race, etc.
5. **A Map of** – WWII Europe, WWII Pacific, Korea, Vietnam, Nuclear destruction zones, American military bases around the world, Fall of the Soviet Union
6. **A Display of** – The Nuclear Triad, Modern Art, the 60's, etc
